TOUR ALPINE ROSE BLOSSOM HIKE

Alpine rose blossom hike on the Planneralm Karlspitz - Schoberspitz - Karlseen - Karlhütte - Schrabachalm

Directions: Hike in the Almrausch blooming Planneralm basin with a summit experience. Beautiful 2 summit hike. From the Planneralmkessel, the hiking trail leads over the beautiful alpine pasture area to above the tree line. Past the lushly blooming and fragrant alpine roses. The hiking trail leads along the ridge to the Karlspitz, then down to the beautiful Karlsee and the Karlhütte. The path descends a little steeper to the Schrabachalm. From there it goes along the road to the starting point back up to the Planneralm.

TOUR 5 SUMMITS HIKE

Riesneralm - Finsterkar - 5 Summits Hike

Directions: This beautiful tour leads over five peaks in the Schladminger Tauern. A varied and very scenic tour high above Donnersbachtal.

At the exit of the chairlift, immediately turn left and follow the markings towards Finsterkaralm, walk past the huts on a narrow hiking trail up towards Finsterkarsee. A wonderful place for a short rest.

We continue along the path up to the ridge. Follow the path that leads below the Finsterkarspitze past the Großer Bärneck. Surefootedness is required here, because the path drops steeply to the left-over meadow slopes into the Sölktal. After a good 30 minutes, you reach the second summit.

Short descent into the saddle and up to the Silberkarspitze. Continue along the ridge to the Gstemmerscharte. The two peaks, Sonntagskarspitz and Schwarzkarspitz can be easily climbed here, or you can cross below the two over towards the Mößnascharte. Then you have completed the last meters of altitude.

Continue the Schusterboden to the northeast. From the tree line, the path leads steeply down into the Mörsbach valley. You can experience the abundance of water up close, because large parts of the path are always wet.



HM: 500 m ascent **Distance:** 5 km



TOUR BLAUFELDSCHARTE

Blaufeldscharte - Unique hike far away from mass tourism in the picturesque Donnersbachtal.

Directions: We follow the forest road along Donnersbach past an old salt pit. Our hiking trail leads from the Riedleralm steadily uphill through an almost untouched nature past the Schwarzaalm to the Blaufeldscharte. Once there, we are rewarded with a view of the beautiful Zaglsee. With sufficient stamina, the hike can be extended to the Talkenshrine (2319 m). The path leads back over the Ildereckscharte to the starting point in Donnersbachwald.

TOUR ST. NIKOLAI - TUCHMOARALM

St. Nikolai (Großsölk) - Seekarlscharte - Tuchmoaralm (Kleinsölk)

Directions: Super beautiful crossing from Großsölktal to Kleinsölktal, past beautiful mountain lakes in an untouched natural landscape.

With the valley bus from Stein/Enns to St. Nikolai. From St. Nikolai, we hike along the Bräualm stream. Up to the picturesque Hohensee, the hiking trail becomes a little steeper, but you are rewarded with a unique view of the lake and the alpine pasture area. Steadily uphill it goes through the untouched natural landscape past the Black Lake and Green Lake to the Seekarl Scharte (highest point of the tour, 2302m). The last part to the saddle requires surefootedness and a head for heights. Down and past the Caribbean-blue Seekarlsee, which invites you to take a break, the somewhat steeper path leads to the Tuchmoaralm. The beautifully situated alpine hut invites you to stop for a bite to eat and refresh yourself. From the Tuchmoaralm, follow the forest path to the car park and the valley bus stop. (Departure 16:18)
